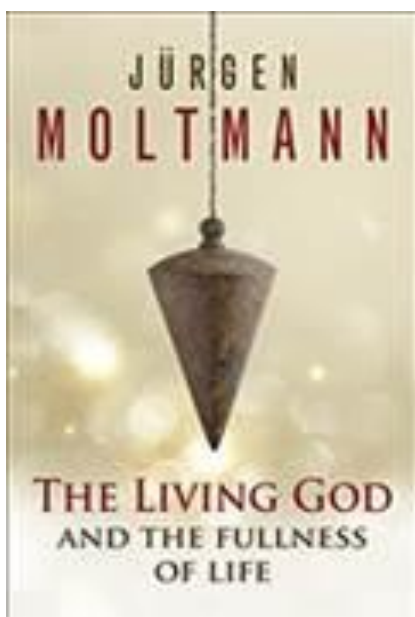


Public Lecture and Book-Signing



Jürgen Moltmann **The Future of Theology**

Noted theologian Jürgen Moltmann will visit the Ecumenical Centre, Geneva, on Wednesday, 13 January, to offer a public lecture. Moltmann's latest work, *The Living God and the Fullness of Life*, has recently been published by WCC Publications. He will speak at 4 pm on "The Future of Theology" and afterward sign books and greet guests at a reception.

Among the most widely read theologians of our time, **Jürgen Moltmann** studied theology while a prisoner of war in England and, after his return to Germany, at Göttingen. From 1953 to 1958 he served as a pastor in Bremen and in 1958-1964 as Professor at the Theological Seminary in Wuppertal. After spending 1964 to 1967 in Bonn, in 1967 he went to Tübingen, where he taught until his retirement. He is author of such deeply influential works as *Theology of Hope*, *The Crucified God*, *The Spirit of Life*, and *The Coming God*.
