The theme for the day will be based on ‘Migration – Welcome and multilateral dialogue’.

The programme will consist of an introductory worship service, followed by a bible study and then presentations, with group table discussions. The programme for the day is still being prepared but as usual, there will be a communal meal with specialities prepared by different communities. The theme is appropriate for the Jeûne Genevois, which commemorates the welcome given by the people of Geneva to the Protestants fleeing persecution in Europe.
